



Mark Certificate Subscriber Agreement

This document is the SSL.com Mark Certificate Subscriber Agreement ("**MC Subscriber Agreement**", "**MC Agreement**", "**MCSA**"). This is a binding, legal document between SSL Corp., a Nevada corporation doing business as SSL.com ("**SSL.com**") and the legal entity ("**Applicant**", "**Subscriber**") that has established a Certificate Services Account with SSL.com in hopes of receiving a Mark Certificate ("**MC**") that has been issued by SSL.com.

The Applicant and SSL.com are defined as "**Parties**" to the agreement. (After a certificate has been issued, an Applicant will be known as a Subscriber.) The Applicant is responsible for designating the "Applicant Roles" described below.

This document describes the terms and conditions under which a Mark Certificate may be requested by the Applicant. All terms and conditions described in the standard SSL.com Subscriber Agreement ("**Subscriber Agreement**") apply in full to any Applicant requesting an MC. This document describes additional steps and information required specifically for Mark Certificates. If there is a conflict between the Subscriber Agreement and MC Agreement, the MC Agreement shall be considered the operating document.

The Applicant is responsible for following all guidelines concerning Mark Certificates which are contained in the SSL.com Certificate Policy and Certification Practices Statement ("**CP/CPS**"). The current edition of the CP/CPS is available for inspection at [SSL.com/repository](https://www.ssl.com/repository).

Applicant asserts that it is a Private Organization that is a legally recognized entity whose existence was created or recognized by a filing with (or an act of) the Incorporating or Registration Agency in its Jurisdiction of Incorporation or Registration, or that it was created or recognized by a Government Agency. The Applicant also asserts that it is not designated as inactive, invalid, non-current, or equivalent on the records of the Incorporating Agency or Registration Agency.

The Applicant designates at least one Natural Person as the Principal Individual associated with the Organization (owner, partner, managing member, director, or officers) to act as the Contract Signer who attests to the representations made in this Subscriber Agreement. The Applicant may also assign a Certificate Requestor to maintain an account at SSL.com to facilitate certificate orders. All Applicant roles must be designated in this Subscriber Agreement.

Designated Applicant Roles

The Mark Certificate process describes three roles that are required for the submission, authorization, and verification of the MC Request. The Applicant must designate the natural persons who will occupy the following Applicant Roles:

1. **Contract Signer:** A natural person who is either the Applicant, employed by the Applicant, or an authorized agent who has express authority to represent the Applicant, and who has authority on behalf of the Applicant to sign Subscriber Agreements. An MC Subscriber Agreement applicable to the SSL.com Certificate Services account that has requested a Mark Certificate must be signed by an authorized Contract Signer.

2. Certificate Requestor: The Mark Certificate Request Form ("**MC Request Form**", "**Mark Certificate Request**", "**MCRF**") must be submitted by an authorized Certificate Requestor. The Certificate Requestor is a natural person who is either the Applicant, employee of the Applicant, an authorized agent who has the express authority to represent the Applicant, or a third party (such as a web hosting company or ISP) that completes and submits an MC Request Form on behalf of the Applicant.
3. Certificate Approver: The Mark Certificate Request must be approved by an authorized Certificate Approver. A Certificate Approver is a natural person who is either the Applicant, employee of the Applicant, or an authorized agent who has express authority to represent the Applicant to (1) act as a Certificate Requestor and to authorize other employees or third parties to act as a Certificate Requestor, and (2) to approve Mark Certificate Requests submitted by other Certificate Requestors.

The Applicant may authorize one individual to occupy two or more of these roles, and/or may authorize more than one individual to occupy any of these roles. Any natural person listed in this document without a designated role may act in any of the abovementioned roles, including Contract Signer. The MC Subscriber Agreement signer is considered a Contract Signer, even if they have not added themselves to the Applicant Roles list.

SSL.com MC Subscriber Agreement

This document shall serve as a Master Agreement between SSL.com and the legal entity listed below. By signing this MC Agreement, the Applicant acknowledges that SSL.com will validate the information in any MC Request submitted by the Applicant, or on behalf of the Applicant, so a publicly trusted Mark Certificate will be issued based on that MCRF. Furthermore, the Applicant acknowledges that SSL.com is under no obligation to issue a Mark Certificate and may refuse issuance for any reason, including a finding that the Applicant, MC Request or other material documents do not meet the industry standard regulations described in the CP/CPS.

The undersigned further confirms that it understands and agrees to the terms, conditions, and requirements given in this MC Agreement, the SSL.com CP/CPS, and any documents referenced therein.

The undersigned confirms that it is the Applicant and seeks to procure one or more Mark Certificates from SSL.com. The undersigned acknowledges that the issuance of the Mark Certificate is dependent on remittance of listed, or negotiated, prices for requested goods/services and failure to complete payment within a timely manner may result in revocation of the Mark Certificate. The undersigned confirms that SSL.com is in no way responsible for any disruption to services or software that they or their clients may face when those items are no longer trusted and they agree to be responsible to any, and all, fiscal, physical, or emotional damages related to the revocation.

The Applicant agrees to be bound by all Mark Certificate Requests, Subscriber Agreements, orders, and other official petitions submitted by any holder of the above listed Applicant Roles. The Applicant must contact SSL.com via written notice to revoke or in any way alter the rights of any occupant of an Applicant Role given above. The method of contact must be one of the following:
